

The second hospital crib donated to the Children's Heart Center has been handed over

The György Gottsegen National Institute of Cardiology Children's Heart Center welcomed the donation.

The decision was made at the end of last year to donate hospital beds to the Children's Heart Center of the György Gottsegen National Institute of Cardiology. The 500,000 HUF budget was enough to buy two hospital cribs, one of which was handed over in December, and the second was delivered to the institute by the employees of the company group yesterday. The crib was handed over on behalf of the company by Dóra Diána Szemerédi, CSR and Internal Communications Senior Manager and Gergely Fonay, Marketing Team Leader.

The mixed real estate services company group places special emphasis on social and environmental responsibility. It conducts its business operations and all its activities for the common good, taking into account the impact on people and the planet in all its decisionmaking. In this spirit, the group provided donations to several foundations and institutes at the end of last year.

The György Gottsegen National Cardiovascular Institute is one of the leading institutions for the treatment of cardiovascular diseases not only in the country, but also in Europe. The Children's Heart Center performs nearly 500 pediatric heart surgeries, 250 catheter interventional operations and 120 catheter ablation treatments annually. The center launched the Hungarian pediatric heart transplant program in 2007 and has performed more than half a hundred successful heart transplants in 10 years.

In addition to the operating floor, the five floors of the institution are occupied by a 9-bed and a 16-bed double intensive care unit, as well as two 16-bed pediatric cardiology / cardiac surgery departments. The donated cribs have been placed in this latter department. The staff of the institute welcomed the donation, as a more modern, comfortable hospital environment contributes to the small patients' recovery. This is not the first time the company group has provided support to the hospital; in 2019 an ECG device was purchased for the Children's Heart Center for 560,000 HUF.

Dóra Diána Szemerédi, CSR and Internal Communications Senior Manager said the following in connection with the donation: "The life-saving and quality-of-life improvement activities performed by the hospital staff, as well as the prevention programs they organize to promote a healthy lifestyle represent a value that is also important to our group, and therefore, supporting the Cardiovascular Institute also is among our long-term plans. We are honored to have been able to contribute with our financial resources to the outstanding work of the institute and thus to the improvement of the health of the patients treated there."
